Conservatives Voted Straight Charge is Perjury in Application to Be Placed on the Voters' List.

No Response by People to the Man 1s Alleged to Have Cast Ballot in Ward Four Yesterday.

Because he is alleged to have cast a vote in Ward Four polling station yesterday, Housseln Rahim, a Hindu. is slated for arrest on a charge of perjury. A warrant for Ms apprehension was issued early this afternoon and will be executed, it is declared, just as soon as the police can lay their hands on the man.

Rahim is well known to the immigration authorities of Vancouver because of his successful resistance of efforts of the Dominion Government to deport him. Rahim, landed in Vancouver about two years ago, and on several occasions has defended in the courts attempts on the part of the immigration officials to ship him out of the country on the ground that he was not legally entitled to admission.
