HINDU MUTINY IN SINGAPORE QUELLED

Marines from Japanese and French Warships Aid in Pacification.

Tokyo, Feb. 20.—A report from Singapore, Straits Settlement, says that the mutiny of the Hindu soldiers has been quelled. Eleven English men and women were killed in the fighting, and some Japanese were wounded.

Marines were landed from Japanese and French warships to quell the disturbance.
