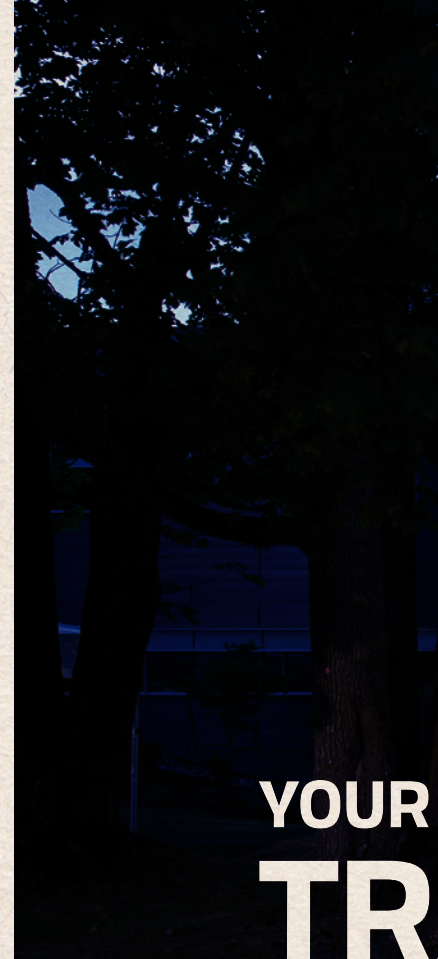
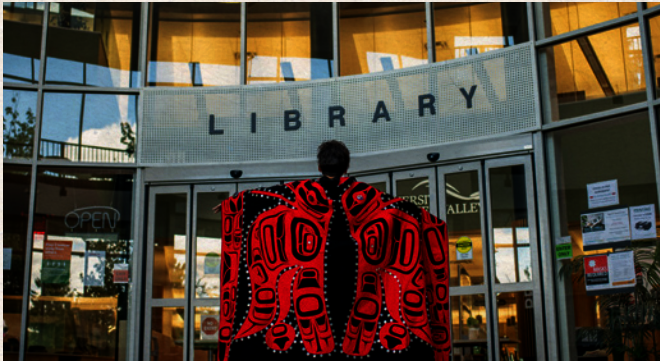

PAYING FOR YOUR EDUCATION

If you're enrolling in the academic year immediately following your high school graduation, you may qualify for a UFV entrance scholarship.
